

Important instructions regarding the internal connector

When using the internal Firewire connector (PORT01), don't plug any device to the first external port (PORT0).

Software installation Installation under Windows XP:

The Firewire card gets installed automatically. You can check if Windows has installed the interface card properly.

Click \Rightarrow Start \Rightarrow Control Panel (in the classic start menu \Rightarrow Start \Rightarrow Settings \Rightarrow Control Panel) \Rightarrow Printers and Other Hardware and then on System below "See Also" (In the classic view please double click on System). In the window system properties please continue with \Rightarrow Hardware \Rightarrow Device Manager. In the section IEEE 1394 Bus host controllers must be an entry "VIA OHCI Compliant IEEE 1394 Host Controller" without a yellow exclamation mark.

Installation under Windows ME:

The card gets installed automatically. Answer the following question about the restart with \Rightarrow **Yes**.

You can check if the IEEE 1394 card has been installed properly. Click \Rightarrow Start \Rightarrow Settings \Rightarrow Control Panel \Rightarrow System \Rightarrow Device Manager \Rightarrow 1394 Bus Controller. There must be an entry "VIA OHCI Compliant IEEE 1394 Host Controller" without a yellow exclamation mark.

Installation under Windows 98 SE:

Shortly after booting, the system is starting the Add New Hardware Wizard and searches for new drivers for "PCI OHCI Compliant IEEE 1394 Host Controller". Please click on \Rightarrow **Next**. In the following window ("What do you want Windows to do?") select "Search for the best driver for your device" \Rightarrow Next \Rightarrow Next \Rightarrow Next. Windows is now copying the necessary drivers. Insert the Windows 98 CD-ROM if needed and then click on "OK" (Possibly you must then enter another drive letter for your CD-ROM drive). Afterwards please click on \Rightarrow **Finish**. You can check if the IEEE 1394 card has been installed properly. Click \Rightarrow Start \Rightarrow Settings \Rightarrow Control Panel \Rightarrow System \Rightarrow Device Manager \Rightarrow 1394 Bus Controller. There must be an entry "PCI OHCI Compliant IEEE 1394 Host Controller" without a yellow exclamation mark.

Installation under Windows 2000 Prof.

The Firewire card gets installed automatically. You can check if Windows has installed the interface card properly. Click \Rightarrow **Start** \Rightarrow **Settings** \Rightarrow **Control Panel** \Rightarrow **System** \Rightarrow **Hardware** \Rightarrow **Device Manager** \Rightarrow **IEEE 1394 Bus host controllers**. There must be an entry "VIA OHCI Compliant IEEE 1394 Host Controller" without a yellow exclamation mark.
